To date, there have not been formal congressional investigations of the USS Liberty incident. However, you may be interested in two congressional reports that involve the USS Liberty, both of which I have attached to this email. The first is the written record of an exchange on the USS Liberty that came out of a hearing before the Senate Armed Services Committee in 1967. The second is a 1971 report from the House Armed Services Committee reviewing worldwide communications of the Department of Defense, including those regarding the USS Liberty.
